STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Lakes and Ponds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2552, sub-§ 1, amended. The first sentence of subsection 1 of section 2552 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

The open season for all fish, except black bass in waters or portions of waters naturally free of iee and except as controlled by special regulations, in lakes and ponds, shall be from April 1st or from when the lakes and ponds are naturally free of ice to September 30th.
