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**AN ACT Relating to Spearing Suckers in Rivers, Streams and Brooks.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2701, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 2701 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

It shall be lawful to take suckers in **all rivers**, brooks and streams which are open to fishing between April ~~15th~~ **1st** and ~~May~~ **June** 30th of each calendar year by the use of a hand spear by persons licensed or otherwise entitled to fish in Maine waters.
