RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Portion of Jordan River, Cumberland County.

Fishing in portion of Jordan River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Jordan River, from Panther Pond to Sebago Lake, Cumberland County, to fishing from April 1st to September 15th and establishing the bag limit and length limit in conformity with that for Sebago Lake.
