AN ACT Relating to Payments to Maine Forestry District by Baxter State Park Authority and Indian Township Improvement Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 901, amended. The next to the last sentence of section 901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

The authority shall make annual payment to the Treasurer of State of the pro rata cost of forest fire protection in the Maine Forestry District for each acre within Baxter State Park. The pro rata cost per acre shall be determined by dividing the cost of forest fire protection in the Maine Forestry District for the last fiscal year by the total number of acres in the Maine Forestry District for the same period.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 22, § 4834, amended. The last sentence of section 4834 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

From said Improvement Fund the department in charge shall make payment to the Treasurer of State of the pro rata cost of forest fire protection in the Maine Forestry District for each acre within Indian Township not already paying such tax. The pro rata cost per acre shall be determined by dividing the cost of forest fire protection in the Maine Forestry District for the last fiscal year by the total number of acres in the Maine Forestry District for the same period.
