COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 167, L.D. 230, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Payment of Fees to Secretary of State Resulting  
in Protest."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"§55-A" (same in L.D. 230) and inserting in place thereof the  
following:

§55-A. Payment of fees resulting in protest

Whenever the payment of any fee, as required in this  
Title, results in a protest or is returned by the bank upon  
which it was drawn because of "Insufficient Funds," "Account  
Closed," "No Account" or any other similar reason, there shall  
be charged a service collection of \$2 plus the cost of collection.
