AN ACT Relating to Payment of Fees to Secretary of State Resulting in Protest.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 55-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 55-A, to read as follows:

§ 55-A. Payment of fees resulting in protest

Whenever the payment of any fee, as required in this Title, results in a protest, there shall be charged a service collection of \$2, in addition to the original fee. Such collection charge shall be applied by the Secretary of State for defraying the expense of making the collection of such protested payment.
