IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Register of Deeds of Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 16th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 and by section 1 of chapter 477, both of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Washington County: County commissioners, \$1,800; clerk of courts, \$3,600; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$2,600; sheriff, \$4,800; register of deeds, \$4,000; judge of probate, \$3,000; register of probate, \$3,600.
