STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Operation of Motor Vehicles by Minors Between Sunset and Sunrise.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 586, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 586, as follows:

§ 586. Minors; hours of operation limited

No person under the age of 21 years shall operate a motor vehicle, other than a motor truck, with a licensed horsepower rating of more than 35 upon any way of this State, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, unless such person is accompanied by the registered owner of such vehicle who is over 21 years of age.

The age of such a person as indicated on his valid driver's license shall be prima facie evidence of correct age as stated in licensee's birth records.
