STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Inspection Certificates for Mechanics in Motor Vehicle Inspection Stations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. Section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph, a new sentence, to read as follows:

There shall be an application fee of \$2 which shall be nonrefundable.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2124 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

Egen appresent of an inspection station, the Chief of the State Police shall iron a livence livence and sign, for which he shall charge an annual fee of \$2.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. Section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes as amended is further amended by adding after the 6th paragraph, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

The Chief of the State Police is authorized to make necessary rules and regulations for qualification for and retention of an inspection mechanic's certificate.

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 2124 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

After hearing, as provided in Title 5, chapters 301 to 307, the Administrative Hearing Commissioner may suspend or revoke the license issued to any official inspection station or the inspection certificate issued to any inspecting mechanic and may refuse the right of relicensing for a period not to exceed 6 months.
