AN ACT Relating to List of Recipients of Aid to the Blind for Determining Eligibity for Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 534-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 534-A, to read as follows:

§ 534-A. List of recipients of aid to the blind

The Department of Health and Welfare shall furnish to the Secretary of State a list of all recipients of aid to the blind and services for the blind. This list shall be used only for the purpose of determining if such recipient is a proper person to have a motor vehicle operator's license.
