COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 178, L.D. 241, Bill, "An
Act Relating to Carrying Operator's License when Operating
Motor Vehicle."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined
sentence and inserting in place thereof the following under-
lined sentence: 'No person charged with violating this
section shall be required to answer a summons and appear in
court if subsequent to apprehension said person produces to a
State Police Officer or any other authorized police officer
an operator's license theretofore issued to him and valid at
the time of the issuance of the aforesaid summons.'
