HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 178, L.D. 241, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Carrying Operator's License when Operating
Motor Vehicle."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following under-
lined sentence: 'If the person charged shall exhibit to a law
enforcement officer designated by the summoning officer such
an operator's license, not later than 24 hours before the time
set for the court appearance, than the complaint shall not issue.'
