SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 178, L. D. 241, Bill, "An Act Relating to Carrying Operator's License when Operating Motor Vehicle."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in L. D. 241) the following underlined sentence: 'If the person charged shall exhibit to a state police officer designated by the summoning officer such an operator's license, not later than 24 hours before the time set for the court appearance, then the complaint shall not issue.'
