STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Proof of Age for Applicant for Motor Vehicle Operator's Permits and Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 581-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 581-A, to read as follows:

§ 581-A. Proof of age

Every person between the ages of 15 and 25 years shall supply to the department satisfactory proof of his date of birth, before the department may accept his application for an examination prior to the issuance of a permit or original license.

This section shall not affect any applicant who has an application on file on January 1, 1968.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 1968.
