AN ACT Providing for Local Traffic-control Devices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 947-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 947-A, to read as follows:

§ 947-A. Local traffic-control devices

Local authorities in their respective jurisdictions shall place and maintain such traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdiction as they may deem necessary to indicate and to carry out this Title or local traffic ordinances or to regulate, warn or guide traffic. All such traffic-control devices erected, after the effective date of this Act, shall conform to the state manual and specifications.
