STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Reclassifying Certain Inland Waters of the Kennebec River Basin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 38, § 368, amended. Subsection 4 of that part of section 368 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes which relates to waters captioned Kennebec River, Main Stem is amended to read as follows:
- 4. From a point 0.5 mile above the southerly boundary of Fairfield and Benton to a line across the Kennebec River Tidal Estuary drawn due west from the southerly extension of Green Point on the easterly shore of the Kennebec River across the channel east of Swan Island to the island, along the easterly shore of Swan Island to southernmost point of the island, thence due west to the westerly shore of the river—Class $\stackrel{\bullet}{\mathbf{D}}$ \mathbf{C} .
