## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Change the Name of Mud Pond, Old Town, to Perch Pond.

Mud Pond; name changed. Resolved: That the name of the pond in Old Town, Penobscot County, heretofore known as Mud Pond, is changed to, and shall be officially named, Perch Pond.
