### AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officials of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2 amended. The 9th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 of the public laws of 1965, which relates to Lincoln County, is further amended to read as follows:

**Lincoln County:** County commissioners, \$1,100; chairman, \$1,100; \$1,300; clerk of courts, \$4,300 \$5,000; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$1,000; sheriff, \$3,800 \$5,000; register of deeds, \$4,300 \$4,700; judge of probate, \$3,500 \$5,000; register of probate, \$4,700.
