AN ACT Relating to Establishing Salary of Deputy Clerk of Courts of Hancock County by County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 and section 2 of chapter 477, both of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Hancock County: County commissioners, \$1,450; clerk of courts, \$4,000; deputy clerk of courts, ~~\$2,850~~ **salary to be established by the county commissioners**; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$2,600; sheriff, \$4,750; register of deeds, \$4,000; judge of probate, \$4,500; register of probate, \$4,000.
