AN ACT Establishing Classified Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 533-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 533-A, to read as follows:

§ 533-A. Classified licenses

The Secretary of State may issue a classified license which shall indicate the classification for which the applicant therefor has qualified by examination or by such other means as the Secretary of State shall prescribe. Such classified license shall entitle the operator to operate a class vehicle for which he has qualified by examination or otherwise and all other vehicles of a lesser class, except no operator may operate a school bus or motorcycle unless he has qualified by examination to operate that type vehicle.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 1969.
