IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Unauthorized Person from Driving a Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 900-A, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 900-A, to read as follows:

§ 900-A. Prohibiting unauthorized person from driving

No person shall authorize or knowingly permit a motor vehicle owned by him or under his control to be driven upon any highway by any person who is not authorized under this Title or in violation of any of the provisions of this Title.
