AN ACT Relating to the Support of Children Committed to the Training Centers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 15, § 2719, additional. Title 15 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2719, as follows:

§ 2719. Support, training center program fund

The Department of Mental Health and Corrections shall charge and shall collect, fees, in accordance with Title 34, chapter 195 for the support of children committed to the center.

All fees received by the Department of Mental Health and Corrections for the support of children committed to the center shall be deposited in the State Treasury, and shall be used in the improvement and conduct of the vocational education and rehabilitation programs at the center, which use shall be upon the recommendation of the superintendent and approval of the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections.

If any of such fees are not expended during the year in which they are collected, the unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall be carried as a continuing account available for the purposes specified, until expended.
