STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Hunting from Automobiles by Double Amputees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2456, amended. The last paragraph of section 2456 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

Notwithstanding this section, paraplegics or double amputees of the legs may hunt from motor vehicles which remain stationary are not in motion.
