IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in McGrath Pond and Salmon Pond in Kennebec County.

Fishing in McGrath Pond and Salmon Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening McGrath Pond and Salmon Pond in Belgrade and Oakland to fishing for all species except salmon, trout and togue during the month of October each year.
