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**AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Forest Management on Indian Township  
Forest Lands.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 22, § 4834, amended.** Section 4834 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

**Whenever foresters are used to practice forest management on Indian Township forest lands held in trust by the State, reimbursement for expenses of materials, supplies and similar expenses incidental thereto shall be deducted from the income received from the sale of stumpage before it is credited to the department that has administration of said lands, subject to prior approval by the Forest Commissioner and Commissioner of Indian Affairs.**
