RESOLVE, Increasing Pension for Margaret H. Frisbee of Belfast.

Margaret H. Frisbee; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$110 per month be granted to Margaret H. Frisbee of Belfast, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1967, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature; and be it further

Resolved, 1963, c. 96, repealed. Resolved: That chapter 96 of the resolves of 1963 which provided for a state pension for Margaret H. Frisbee of Belfast is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Margaret Frisbee is now receiving a pension of \$60 per month. She was living with an uncle but since his death, she has been boarding at various places. She is now in the Hillside Nursing Home in Belfast at the rate of \$110 monthly. She is under guardianship and is not able to work.
