AN ACT Relating to Membership of Aeronautics Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 6, § 41, repealed and replaced. Section 41 of Title 6 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

§ 41. Appointment; term

The Aeronautics Commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 5 members to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council. One member of the commission shall be a commercial airport operator, one member shall be regularly employed in the aviation trades and 3 members shall be in no way connected with the aviation industry. One member shall be appointed by the Governor as chairman who shall devote each full working day to his duties and whose salary shall be fixed by the Governor and Council. The term of office of the chairman shall be 5 years, subject only to removal for cause. The other members shall be appointed for a term of 3 years and any vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. Each member, other than the chairman, shall receive as compensation for each day actually spent on the work of the commission the sum of \$20 and his actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of duties pertaining to his office.
