STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Annex Bar Island to Town of Bar Harbor, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Bar Island annexed to Town of Bar Harbor. Bar Island, located in Frenchman's Bay, in the County of Hancock, and presently within the boundaries of the Town of Gouldsboro, is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Town of Bar Harbor, in the County of Hancock.
- Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall only become effective when the Town of Bar Harbor pays to the Town of Gouldsboro, the sum of \$5,000 for loss of tax revenue to the Town of Gouldsboro in the annexation of Bar Island to the Town of Bar Harbor. The Town of Bar Harbor is authorized to raise or appropriate the necessary funds for the purpose of this Act.
