SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 183, L. D. 297, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Conveyance of Secondary Pupils."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 8th and 9th lines  
(5th and 6th lines of L. D. 297) the underlined words "and for  
secondary pupils to the unit's secondary school or schools"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'and for  
secondary pupils to a school or schools as designated by the unit'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 the  
following underlined sentences: 'No unit shall be required to  
transport secondary pupils to more than one secondary school  
unless it operates more than one such school within its own  
jurisdiction, nor to schools already served at appropriate times  
by existing public transportation. The State shall pay to the  
transporting unit or units subsidies in accordance with existing  
statutes.'
