STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Education of Members of Lewiston Police Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 7-B, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 as amended is further amended by adding a new section 7-B to read as follows:

Sec. 7-B. Continuing education. The city shall make available the sum of \$2,000 for the purpose of ensuring the continuing education of members of the police department. This amount shall be used to defray the costs of attending schools, seminars, courses in the various police sciences and materials used for such schools. The police commission shall prescribe the schools, seminars and courses to be attended acting upon the advice of the chief of police. The sum of \$2,000 shall be made available on an annual basis.
