COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 217, L.D. 307, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Use of Power Boats on Jordan Pond and Eagle  
Lake, Mount Desert Island, Hancock County."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 3 under-  
lined lines (last 2 in L.D. 307) and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'No person, except officers empowered to enforce this  
subchapter, shall operate a motorboat having more than 10 horse-  
power on Eagle Lake and Jordan Pond, Mt. Desert Island, Hancock  
County.'
