HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 217, L.D. 307, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Use of Power Boats on Jordan Pond and  
Eagle Lake, Mount Desert Island, Hancock County."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the period in the  
Title (same in L.D. 307) the following words and punctuation:  
'and Little Ellis Pond (Garland Pond), Byron, Oxford County'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning  
of the first line (same in L.D. 307) the following underlined  
abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following  
(same in L.D. 307):

'Sec. 2. R.S., T. 38, § 243, additional. Chapter 38 of  
the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 243, to  
read as follows:

§243. Little Ellis Pond; use of power boats

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this  
subchapter, shall operate a motorboat having more than 10 horse-  
power on Little Ellis Pond (Garland Pond), Byron, Oxford County.'
