**AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on Jordan Pond and Eagle Lake,  
Mount Desert Island, Hancock County.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 38, § 242, additional.** Chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 242, to read as follows:

**§ 242. Eagle Lake and Jordan Pond; use of power boats**

**No person shall operate an outboard motor boat having more than 10 horsepower on Eagle Lake and Jordan Pond Mount Desert Island, Hancock County.**
