IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Granting Complimentary Fishing Licenses for Certain Maine Residents in Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2301, sub-§ 2-A, additional. Section 2301 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection 2-A, to read as follows:

2-A. Complimentary licenses for Maine residents in Armed Forces. The commissioner is authorized to issue complimentary fishing licenses for a period of 2 weeks or less to Maine residents in the Armed Forces of the United States who are in Maine on leave or furlough.
