Bill, "An Act Relating to a Closed Season on Wild Hares and
Rabbits in York County."

Amend said Amendment in the last line by inserting after the
underlined word and punctuation "September." the following under-
lined sentence: 'It shall be unlawful to hunt wild hares or rabbits
in the County of Washington with dogs from the first day of November
to the 5th day of December of each year.'

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Further amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words
"York County" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Washington
and York Counties'
