## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Certain Disqualifications of Benefits Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1193, sub-§ 4, amended. The first sentence of subsection 4 of section 1193 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 16 of chapter 381 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

For any week with respect to which the commission finds that his total or partial unemployment is due to a stoppage of work which exists, other than a lockout, because of a labor dispute which is in active progress at the factory, establishment or other premises at which he is or was employed.
