STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Certain Disqualifications of Benefits Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1193, sub-§ 5, amended. The last sentence of subsection 5 of section 1193 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 18 of chapter 381 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

If such remuneration under paragraphs A and C is less than the benefits which would otherwise be due under this chapter, he shall be entitled to receive for such week, if otherwise eligible, benefits reduced by the amount of such remuneration, provided that any fraction of a dollar included in the weekly remuneration received shall be disregarded; except that, with respect to pension payments, no claimant will be disqualified from receiving benefits nor will benefits be reduced, because of such payments if his benefits are based entirely on wages earned from employment other than that from which he retired;
