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**AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor to Government Instrumentalities and Excise  
Tax on Malt Beverages Sold to Vessels of Foreign Registry.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 204, amended.** The last sentence of section 204 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**The commission may sell at the same discount price spirituous and vinous liquor to approved government instrumentalities within the State.**

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 452, amended.** The 4th paragraph of section 452 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**A refund shall be granted for the excise tax imposed by this State on malt beverages sold by wholesalers to any vessel of foreign registry. Any wholesaler selling to such vessel shall present proof of such sale to the commission and shall thereupon receive from the Treasurer of State a refund of all state excise taxes paid in connection with such sale.**
