COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 233, L.D. 341, Bill, "An Act Providing for a Council-Manager Charter for the Town of Cape Elizabeth."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 4." of Article II and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 4. Compensation. Councilmen shall receive for their services \$10 for each council meeting attended, not to exceed \$300 per year for each councilman. Such compensation may be changed by ordinance. The council by order shall fix the salaries of officials appointed by the council, including the salary of the town manager for his services as such and for all other services rendered by him. Salaries of the appointees of the town manager shall be fixed by the town manager, subject to approval of the council.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 3." of Article III and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Department heads. All statutory officers and department heads other than listed in Article II, section 3, subsection 1, shall be appointed and removed by the town manager, both subject to approval of the council.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1." of Article VIII and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All ordinances and any vote for a capital expenditure or capital improvement the total cost of which exceeds \$100,000, except emergency ordinances as defined in Article II, section 12, shall be subject to overrule by a referendum as follows:'
