HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 240, L.D. 348, Bill, "An Act
Prohibiting Hauling Lobster Pots on Sundays."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:
'From June 1st to October 31st of each year, during the period 1/2 hour after sunset until 1/2 hour before sunrise of the following morning, it is unlawful for any person to raise, haul or transfer from the tidal waters of this State any pot, trap or other contrivance that is set for the taking of lobsters or crabs ~~during the period 1/2 hour after sunset until 1/2 hour before sunrise of the following morning~~. From June 1st to August 31st of each year, during the period from 4 p.m., Eastern Daylight Saving Time, on Saturday to 1/2 hour before sunrise of the following Monday morning it is unlawful for any person to raise, haul or transfer from the tidal waters of this State any pot, trap or other contrivance that is set for the taking of lobsters or crabs.'
