HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 246, L.D. 354, Bill, "An Act Relating
to the Appointment of Clerks of the Judicial Courts."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that
clerks of the judicial courts shall continue in office until the
expiration of their present terms.'
