SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 246, L.D. 354, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Appointment of Clerks of the Judicial Courts."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following: '<u>It shall not be a requirement for appointment as a clerk of the</u> <u>judicial courts that the appointee be an attorney at law. The</u> <u>clerk shall be a resident of the county served. Salaries of the</u> <u>clerks shall be paid by the county served, in such amount as shall</u> <u>be determined by the Legislature.</u>

<u>Sec. 2. Intent</u>. It is the intent of the Legislature that clerks of the judicial courts shall continue in office until the expiration of their present terms.'
