**AN ACT Relating to Trespass on Unimproved Land Devoted to Preservation
of Wildlife.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3859, amended. Section 3859 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 64 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

For the purposes of this section unimproved land devoted to the preservation of wildlife shall include that portion of any public way which crosses said land.
