## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Employee Under Minimum Wage Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 26, § 663, sub-§ 3, ¶ C, repealed. Paragraph C of subsection 3 of section 663 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:
  - C. Any individual employed as a waiter, waitress, ear hop, not to include counter waiters or waitresses, or those whose tips are required to be divided with others; doorman or bellhop, or as a chambermaid in a resort establishment; or those employees whose earnings are derived in whole or in part from sales commissions and whose hours and places of employment are not substantially controlled by the employer;
