COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 270, L.D. 391, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Suspension of Motor Vehicle Operator's License
Pending Appeal in Operating Under the Influence Cases."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'If any person convicted of any violation of this section
shall appeal from the judgment and sentence of the trial court,
his license and right to operate a motor vehicle in this State
shall be suspended during the time his appeal is pending in
the appellate court, unless the trial court shall otherwise
order, or unless the Secretary of State, after a hearing, shall
restore the license or permit pending decision on the appeal;
provided that in all cases of first conviction under this
section the license and right to operate a motor vehicle shall
not be suspended during the time his appeal is pending in an
appellate court. ~~The license of any person, against whom~~
~~probable cause is found and who is held under bail pending the~~
~~action of the grand jury for the violation of this section, shall~~
~~be suspended until the final disposition of the charge.'~~
