IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Weekly Benefit Amounts Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 26, § 1191, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 1191 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 10 of chapter 381 and amended by section 3 of chapter 457, both of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:
- 4. Maximum amount of benefits. The maximum amount of benefits which shall be paid to any eligible individual with respect to any benefit year, whether for total or partial unemployment, shall not exceed the lesser of ± 6 39 times his weekly benefit amount or 33 I/3%, rounded to the nearest dollar, of his total wages paid for insured work during his base period.
