

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 103rd LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 278, L.D. 398, Bill, "An Act Creating a Hospital Administrative District #1 in Penobscot County."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after the words and punctuation "Drew Plantation," in the 4th line (same in L.D. 398) the words and punctuation 'Webster Plantation,'; and by striking out the words "do hereby" in the 5th line (4th line in L.D. 398) and inserting in place thereof the words 'are hereby permitted to'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 5th line (4th line in L.D. 398) the word "annual"

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last paragraph (same in L.D. 398) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'Each member of the board of directors may be paid \$8 for each official meeting of the board that he attends, and no director shall be employed by the hospital district. The treasurer may in addition be paid an annual salary, the stipend to be determined.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 6 (same in L.D. 398) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 6. Budget. The administrator of the hospital district shall prepare a yearly detailed budget of proposed expenditures for the current year, January 1st to December 31st. The budget must be voted upon by the members present at an annual district meeting.'

Further amend said Bill in section 7 by inserting after the word "Act" in the last line (same in L.D. 398) the following words and punctuation ', or any property, real or personal or mixed, may be distributed to any nonprofit organization, if so voted by all member towns in the district at legally constituted meetings'

Further amend said Bill in section 8 by striking out all of the first sentence (same in L.D. 398) and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: 'After the formation of the hospital district, if there is another town which wishes to join the hospital district, it may do so by majority vote at its town meeting, plus the acceptance of said town by a majority vote at the district meeting.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
