STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Local Option for Sale of Malt Liquor to be Consumed on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 101, sub-§ 4, repealed and replaced. Subsection 4 of section 101 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 4. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquors) to be consumed on the premises of hotels and clubs?
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 101, sub-§ 4-A, additional. Section 101 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 4-A, as follows:
- 4-A. Shall licenses be granted in this city or town for sale herein of malt liquor (beer, ale and other malt liquors) to be consumed on the premises of restaurants?
