AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Jury Commissioners of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 1252, amended. The first paragraph of section 1252 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The jury commissioners for the several counties shall each receive for their services the following sums per year, and expenses: Androscoggin, \$150; Aroostook, \$100; Cumberland, \$250; Franklin, \$75; Hancock, \$75 \$100; Kennebec, \$100; Knox, \$75; Lincoln, \$75; Oxford, \$75; Penobscot, \$100; Piscataquis, \$50; Sagadahoc, \$75; Somerset, \$75; Waldo, \$75; Washington, \$75; York, \$100.
