**AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorneys
of Penobscot County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30 § 2, amended. That part of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Penobscot County, as last repealed and replaced by section 59 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Penobscot County: County commissioners, \$2,500; clerk of courts, \$5,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,500; county attorney, ~~\$6,000~~ **\$8,000**; first assistant county attorney, ~~\$5,000~~ **\$6,000**; second assistant county attorney, ~~\$4,000~~ **\$5,000**; county treasurer, \$3,500; sheriff, \$5,800; register of deeds, \$5,000; judge of probate, \$5,900; register of probate, \$4,800.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$4,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney, first assistant county attorney and second assistant county attorney of Penobscot County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
